What is Big Bag Recovery?

Big Bag Recovery is a product stewardship program for plastic bags of 15kg/L of contents (sacks and bulk bags). The program aims to ensure that the plastic packaging bags are collected and recycled into other products preventing them from entering the waste stream.

What does this mean for me?

This means that all Whitfert branded bulk bags are able to be included in the program and recover the plastics to reuse as other products. If you purchase Whitfert fertiliser in a bulk bag you are able to drop the bag back to our depot which will be picked up by Big Bag Recovery for recycling.

What do the bulk bags get recycled into?

Big Bag Recovery recycle the bulk bags into resin pellets which are then manufactured into items such as plant pots, furniture for parks and schools, shipping pallets, water evaporation lids and other useful products.

Why should I return my bags to the depot?

As a safety precaution, Whitfert branded bulk bags are single trip bags and should not be reused after being emptied. Therefore, the next best option for a circular economy is to recycle them. All costs for recycling the bulk bags have been covered by Whitfert, all that is required is the return of the bulk bags to our depot.

An estimated 80,000 tonnes of this packaging are introduced into Australia each year. Together with your support we aim to reduce this and reuse the packaging to create other useful recyclable products.
